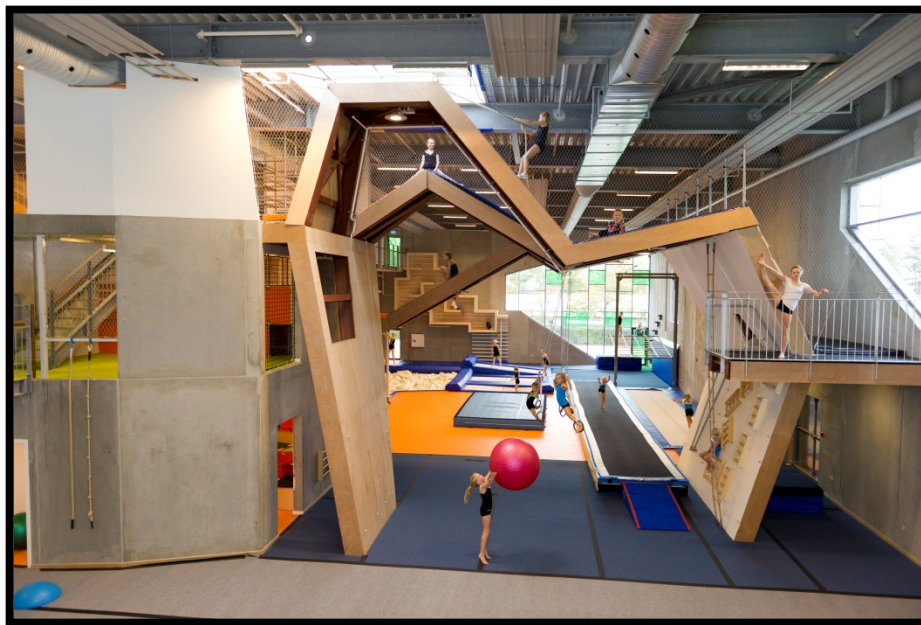
# The Danish Foundation for Culture and Sports Facilities

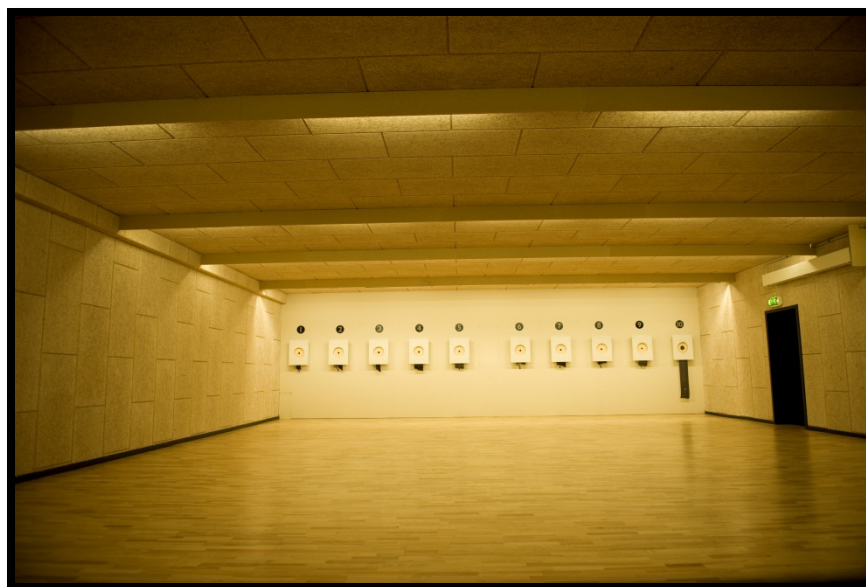
