

ISCA General Assembly 2013

Procedure for nomination, presentation and elections to ISCA Executive Committee

The ISCA General Assembly 2013 will be held in Barcelona on Saturday 19th October in connection with the MOVE Congress 2013.

During the General Assembly we will discuss and decide the future priorities of ISCA. Every second year, we also hold elections for the ISCA Executive Committee. 2013 is an election year for the Executive Committee. The following positions are up for elections:

- President (one)
- Vice Presidents (two)
- Executive Committee members (five)

The nominations should be received by ISCA Secretary General (js@isca-web.org) and ISCA President (mk@isca-web.org) by e-mail **no later than 7th September at 12.00 GMT** (six weeks before the General Assembly).

Nominated candidates are invited to:

1/Produce a short video where candidates present themselves

(Maximum length three minutes. It could be a simple recording of a speech, or other formats you may prefer).

2/ Present themselves through a Curriculum Vitae.

3/ Describe the candidate's vision for ISCA and the sector of "Sport for All".

(The vision should be around 500 words)

4/Describe how the ISCA member organisation, which the candidate is related to, can support the candidate's work in the ISCA Executive Committee.

These materials can be sent to js@isca-web.org after the nomination. ISCA kindly asks that you send these well in advance of the General Assembly, ideally before 19 September (four weeks before the General Assembly). Once received, ISCA will make them available on the ISCA website.

From ISCA Statutes on election

As a Principle of striving towards a geographical balance:

- a) No country or organisation can have more than two members elected to the Executive Committee.*
- b) The President or any of the Vice-Presidents shall not represent the same country, region or organisation.*

The General Assembly shall elect the Executive Committee.

Nominations with acceptance by the nominal person of the position are valid only if they have been received by the President six weeks at least before the General Assembly.
