

The *Latin American Youth Committee* has started your activities during the ISCA's General Assembly on 2001 at Campinas – Brazil. Within these nine years, the LAYC members have been involved with meetings, courses, events and actions organizations, providing a learning, teaching and practice atmosphere. The group is formed by youngsters from different ISCA's members, gathered by the personal ambition on create, incorporate and materialize different possibilities of knowledge and cultural exchange, through Sports or Cultural practices and themes, always concerned with keeping the high spirit and the joy of all the involved.

The 2009/2010 year has been fulfilled with activities for different target groups, developed at different places, with different aims. It has been, on total, six official meetings, two running projects and an international representation; directly, 62 people were involved with LAYC activities during the 2010 first semester.

The project ***Sport in topic Sport in practice*** was developed from some LAYC members individual needs to clarify the definition of Sport. It was proposed to be a theoretical moment, an academic speech about the main sports conception in literature. As result, the group has organized a short meeting at the School of Physical Education of the State University of Campinas (UNICAMP), Brazil, where the participants could join, at the first moment, to this thematic speech and, after approximately 40 minutes, experience the Ultimate Frisbee practice. The event, even without a large announcement, has gathered 17 participants.

The **1996 - 2010 IYLE's Meeting**, second project developed and supported LAYC, took place on the 3rd and 4th July, at SESC-Campinas/SP, in Brazil. A special opportunity for gathering the participants from Brazil and Uruguay. There were 45 International Youth Leader Education former participants and two next exchange students, which were all involved on an atmosphere of exchanging experiences and perspectives about the program and its potentialities after graduating. Having the presence of **Elizabeth Paoliello, Herbert Hartmann, Maria Luiza Souza Dias**, the meeting was held, mainly, by **Bo Busk Madsen** and **Cristiane Fiorin-Fulgsan**, focusing on how to build and hold up personal projects

LAYC has been represented through its chairwoman – Helaine Lima – in the World Youth Conference, which happened from August 23rd till 27th in Mexico. The Conference was held by Mexican government and by the United Nations System as a space for discussing themes like: Education; Culture; Sports; Participation and International Cooperation. LAYC had its participation in the Parallel Activities, inside the Global Interactive Forum (in which 6000 persons could participate during the 5 days), with a Youth Dialogue about the IYLE's Program.

The Latin American Youth Committee turns now the principal focus and concerns for the individual needs, creation and exchange process. Believing on the given energy of each person to his/her on project, idea, ambition, LAYC starts closing this year's doors, looking forward and reflecting about the future; how to build-up a youngster network, centered on personal projects? How to possibility the ideas, suggestions, help and action exchange among the project's developers? How to offer a complete perspective of ongoing projects and personal ideas in Latin America? These, and other questions, have been through the group's last meetings and actions to build up 2010/2011 scenario.
