

- Life challenges
- Living conditions
- Lack of supportive structures
- Lack of environmental opportunities

For Example: Women in Difficult Life Situations

Barriers to physical activity

- Child care (lack of, high costs)
- Lack of time and money
- Lack of social support
- Inadequate offers
- Lack of access to facilities



Why Sports Organizations?

- Nationwide existence of 90.000 sports clubs in Germany
- Manifold infrastructures
- Wide expertise
- Qualification options
- Open participation structures need for voluntary engagement



- Ideology of open access for all population groups
- Low membership fees

Challenges for Sports Organizations

- Structures primarily serving the interests of members
- Insufficient access to physically inactive and socially disadvantaged populations
- Vague understanding of benefits
- Narrow personal resources due to voluntary work
- Unsuitable infrastructures for target groups




