SPORT FOR ALL IN ROMANIA

– MAIN DATES

- In 1990, Romania joined the International Charter of Physical Education and Sport and took over the name "Sport For All".
- in 1992, by the order of the Minister no. 90/20.01, the Romanian Federation Sports For All is founded. The Federation optimizes the activity, elaborates and launches programs which create the frame conditions that guarantee the right to move.
- In 2000, after The Law of Physical Education and Sports majority sports structures at different levels are reorganized and become private non-governmental organizations.


