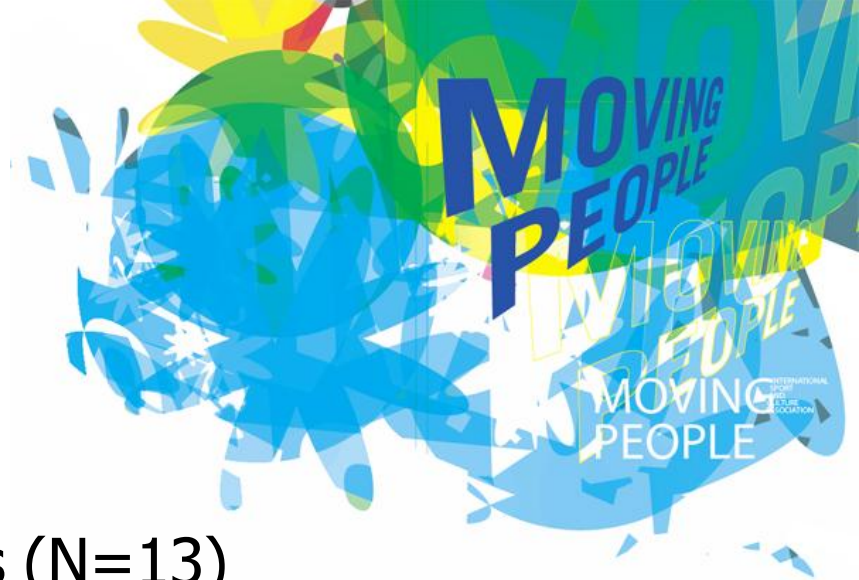

Answers from the questionnaires (N=13)

Mainly public facilities	4	31 %
Mainly public facilities managed by private companies/societes	0	0 %
Mainly public facilities managed by sports organisations	4	31 %
Mainly private facilities owned by private companies	0	0 %
Mainly private facilities owned by sport organisations	2	15 %
Mix of public and private facilities	6	46 %

Answers from the questionnaires

5 out of 13 organisations have own facilities:

3 of them less than 5 facilities

1 of them has 5 – 10 facilities

1 of them has more than 25 facilities

Facility types include sport halls, swimming pools, outdoor fields, accomodation, office and conference facilities
